- Jodi Yoshioka, the Head of St. Clement's School, presented the following information to the vestry:
 - Anticipating full enrollment
 - The students and staff are enjoying the use of their new covered space on the second floor of B-building.
- The Property Committee has taken the following actions:
 - Approved and began work on the security fence, which will run from the behind the Parish Hall and B-building
 - The school security lighting project has been completed. All the outdoor fixtures have been updated with LED lights on timers.
- Many of our community groups are returning to in-person meetings and the Vi and Paul Loo Parish House. This includes our AA groups, mental health support groups, and Tae Kwon Do.
