St. Clement's is a parish church. Although it is quaint, it is not a wedding chapel. Therefore, the following guidelines have been established for couples wishing to be married here:

- At least one participant must have a close relationship with a current active parishioner.
- At least one participant is a baptized Christian.
- At least one participant is active in an Episcopal parish in his/her home town.
- The couple must have at least 4 pre-marriage counseling sessions with an Episcopal priest or licensed marriage counselor
- St. Clement's must receive a minimum of 6 months notice prior to the wedding date.
- No wedding date will be set with the church until the couple has had at least one meeting with the rector.
- Although St. Clement's clergy should be the primary officiant, other clergy are welcome to participate.
- If either party is divorced, permission must be granted by the Episcopal Bishop of Hawaii before proceeding any farther.
- Should you decide to cancel the wedding, please do so as soon as possible by notifying the parish office in writing and by telephone at 808-955-7745.
